

Export Instructions

1 BUILD SMART PREVIEWS

In the Library Module, select the entire Collection Set you wish to send. Under the Library Menu at the top, choose "Build Smart Previews" under "Previews".

This can take several minutes depending on your Collection Set size.

2. EXPORT CATALOG

Once building smart previews has finished, choose "Export as Catalog" under the File Menu at the top.


3. SAVE THE CATALOG

Save as the name you will remember as the original version, i.e., including "to edit" at the end. Save to a place you will be able to find the folder again.

Make sure to check "Build/Include Smart Previews".

This is the filed you will upload to us using our wetransfer link.

Import Instructions

1. SAVE FINAL EDIT

Save the folder sent via wetransfer to a location where you can easily find it. We will send back with a new name such as "completed edit" at the end.

2. IMPORT CATALOG

Once the final edit folder is saved, in Lightroom under the "File Menu" choose "Import from Another Catalog". This will prompt you to navigate to the completed lightroom catalog location, select the final edit catalog and click "Choose".
